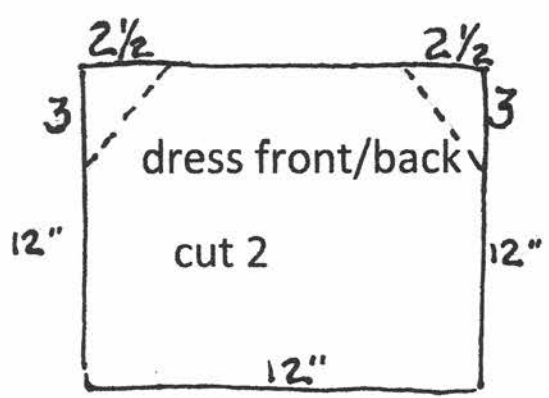




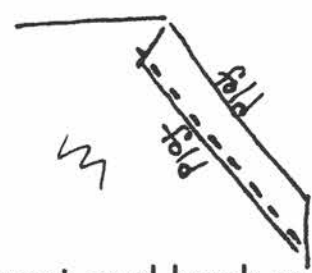

PILLOWCASE DOLL DRESS

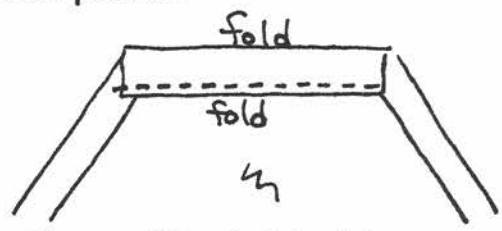
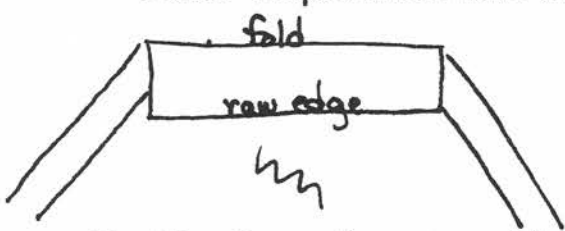


2 pieces of ribbon 22 inches long

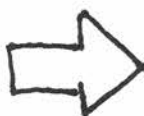
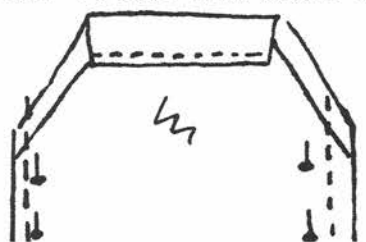
1. On ONE dress piece fold the angled edge of fabric over $\frac{3}{4}$ inch to the inside. Press. Turn back half way to make a skinny hem. Stitch close to the inside fold. Repeat on other three corners.



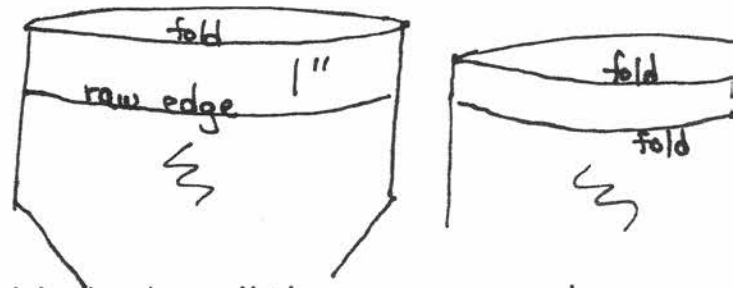
2. Turn TOP edges of dress front and back over to the inside $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch and press. Fold the cut edge under so it now measures 1 inch. Press again. Stitch close to the inside fold. Repeat on the other dress piece.



3. Pin dress front and back together with right sides touching. Make a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch seam down both sides. Remember to backstitch when you start and stop the seam. Press the side seams open.



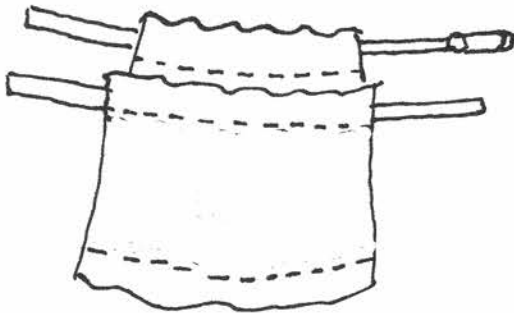
4. Fold bottom hem to inside 1 inch and press. Fold the "raw" edge back the crease you just pressed to make a double hem. Press again.



5. Stitch close to the inside folded edge all the way around the dress hem. Turn right side out.



6. Cut two pieces of ribbon 22 inches long. Using a safety pin thread the ribbon through the casing on the dress front. Repeat with the other ribbon on the dress back.



Put doll in dress and tie ribbons at the shoulders.

What an easy dress! Make shorter to make a blouse to go with a simple skirt or shorts.
