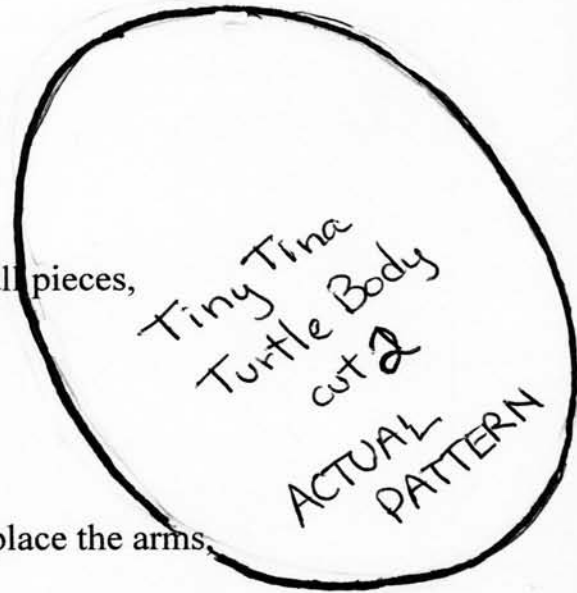
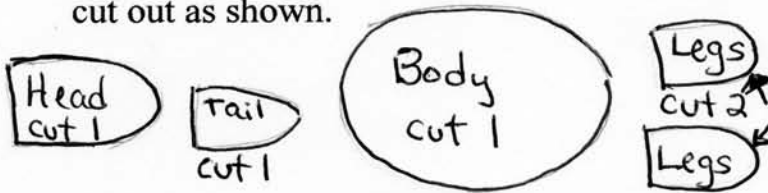


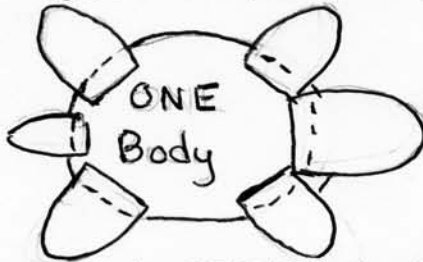
TINY TINA TURTLE

This is an easy project made of felt.

- Using different colored felt for the body and small pieces, cut out as shown.



- Separate the body pieces. On ONE turtle body, place the arms, legs, and head, and pin in place.

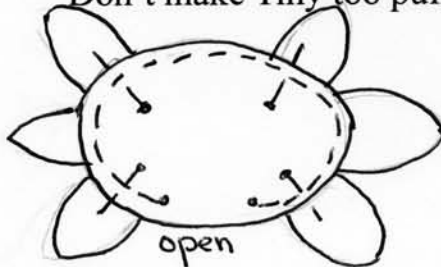


To keep in place, stitch the small pieces close to the edge by hand or machine.

- Place the OTHER body piece on top of what you just worked on. Pin the body pieces together.



- Thread the sewing machine and set on a medium straight stitch. Stitch around the turtle, leaving an opening on the side for stuffing. Don't make Tiny too puffy.



- Pin closing together. Continue stitching to finish your turtle. Tiny Tina is done, except for some eyes. Use an ink pen to draw eyes and mouth.
